Minutes

- The meeting started at approximately 6:40.

Coach Wayne Capra

- Coach Capra shared a brief note and explained how he would like to be involved in with the SFSA and the development at the youth level. He also gave us some of the details as to his history and accomplishments with other schools and clubs. If there is room on the travel rosters, he would like to be added to all.
- The question was posed to inquire if he would be interested in filling or partially filling the organizations Player & Coach Development Coordinator position. He wanted to know and understand what the responsibilities would include. A formal description was not available. The board articulated what we envisioned. The discussion was to ensure development opportunities at both the in house and travel levels. While Coach Capra indicated that he had limited open time, he would still like to be involved. Jen will put together a formal list of responsibilities and share with the board. This information will then be sent to Coach Capra for feedback.
- Confirmed that Coach Capra is interested in coaching the U17 girls travel team this spring.
- He also mentioned that he would like to take the U17 girls team to the Open in Edinboro this summer.
- The board unanimously voted to add Coach Capra to all of the travel rosters as Coach and Player Development Coordinator.
- The board voted and unanimously agreed to accept Coach Capra to fill the Player and Coach Development Coordinator position pending his review of the responsibilities that are under development.

- Field **insurance certificates** will be requested for the three school fields. The elementary school field, the middle school field and the high school stadium.
- Pam presented **Treasurers report**.
- **Roster Issues** – There will be travel coached meeting on Saturday, 02/11/06 at 10:00 in the Shop N Save meeting room. At this meeting Gregg will review the rule changes and rosters. All individuals playing up will required a completed consent form.

- **Holy Child / Koppers** - Pat Egan has inquired about splitting the cost of the first lining for Koppers just as in the past years. All agreed and Pat will be contacted.
- First lining of the field at **Hogan and Fairview** – The board voted and unanimously agreed to contact Shamrock for the first linings of these two fields.
- **Tryouts** – Both Jen Satler and Brian Zura agreed to assist if tryouts are necessary. The tryouts may not be necessary until the fall 2006 season.
- The **coached meeting in California** is scheduled for March 5, 2006 at 4:00.
- **Future Issues**
 - Kohl's Cup** – Do we suspend in house play for that Saturday with the option to add the missed Saturday at the end of the season which may put us in early November. The tentative date for the Kohl's Cup is 09/23/06.
 - PA West proposed \$25.00 per travel team charge – fall 2006.** How do we pay? Pam advised that we can cover this cost.
- The **softball association** has requested a list of the soccer associations email address to distribute a flyer for the **5K run**. The board unanimously agreed not to share the list. Instead we will offer to place the flyer on the SFSA website.
- **New player registration** for spring. Both the additional players for the U7/U8 girls and boys will be able to be blended into the existing teams. Crickets will have 5 new teams for the spring season.
- U7/8 & U9/10 **game length** was discussed. Agreed to 2 – 24 minutes halves for the U9/10 and 4 – 10 minute quarters for the U7/8
